This offense constitutes a Class "A" misdemeanor and is punishable by imprisonment and shall not exceed one (1) year in the county jail and a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$2,500.00) or both a fine and imprisonment. Against the peace and dignity of the State of Arkansas.

Committed as follows: Count # 2; Offense: **Assault 1st Degree**

The defendant or accomplice on or about Friday, January 23, 2026, in Independence County, Arkansas a person commits assault in the second degree if he or she recklessly engages in conduct that creates a substantial risk of physical injury to another person. Committed as follows: Count # 2;      **Offense: Endangering the Welfare of a Minor 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree**


